IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. For the purpose of application fee, the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PWBD category, the candidate must possess a certificate issued by Competent Authority (as applicable to category/format provided by AIIMS Raipur).
- 2. OBC (NCL) certificate must be issued within one year of last date for application 02.06.2024 (i.e. issued between 01.06.2023 to 02.06.2024).
- 3. EWS certificate should be issued on or after on 01.04.2024 to last date of filling of application form i.e. 02.06.2024 based on the income of year 2023-24.
- 4. ST/SC/PWBD certificate should be issued before the last of the application i.e. 02.06.2024.

5. METHOD OF SELECTION:

- 1. Written test.
- 2. There are 100 MCQs in the entrance examination.

3. There will be no negative marking.

6. FINAL RESULT:

- A. Final result will be declared based on total marks obtained in Written Examination. The percentile scores will be used to determine eligibility for admission. The candidate must secure 50th percentile mark to be eligible for admission. Merit list will be prepared as per percentile score.
- B. Based on the percentile obtained in the entrance examination selected candidate will undergo scrutiny for the verification of their documents and final selected list of the candidates will be prepared accordingly subject to fulfilling the eligibility in all terms described in the eligibility criteria mentioned the **clause 2** of the advertisement.

After the entrance examination provisional selection list will be published in the AIIMS Raipur website i.e. <u>www.aiimsraipur.edu.in</u>.

7. METHOD OF RESOLVING TIES:

If two or more candidates obtain equal percentile score in the entrance examination then their inter-semerit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:-

- i. A candidate older in age will rank senior to the candidate younger in age.
- ii. If the age is also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in the Essential Qualification will rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lesser marks.

8. JOINING:

Selected candidates are required to join on or before 31.07.2024. In case the candidate fails to join by this date and no written request for extension is received by 15.07.2024, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list. Last date for admission to the course will be 31.07.2024. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended after 31.07.2024. This includes candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates does not join. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

The admission to the course will be fully provisional subject to verification of all essential documents in original.

10. HOW TO APPLY:

Guidelines for scanning the photograph & Signature:

Before applying online a candidate will be required to have a scanned (JPG, JPEG) image of his/her photograph and signature as per the specifications given below:

(i) Photograph:

- Photograph must be recent passport size coloured, preferably white, background.
- Caps, hats and dark glasses are not allowed. Religious headwear is allowed but it must not cover the face.
- Dimensions 200 x 230 pixels (preferred)
- Size of JPG file should be between 80 kb–100 kb essentially
- Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 100 KB.
- (ii) Signature:
 - The applicant has to sign on white paper with Black ink pen by the applicant.
 - The signature will be used to put on the Hall Ticket and wherever necessary.
 - If the Applicant's signature on the answer script, at the time of the examination, does not match the signature on the Hall Ticket, the applicant will be disqualified.
 - Dimensions 140 x 60 pixels (preferred)
 - Size of file should be between 50 kb 80 kb essentially
 - Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 80 KB.

Please strictly follow this instruction.

- (C) Applicants must fill all the fields <u>carefully</u> since after submission of online application request for change in any information at any later stage will <u>NOT</u> be considered.
- (D) The candidates are requested to fill the correct details regarding name/age/sex/caste/address/educational qualification and other relevant fields mentioned in the application.
- (E) Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as INCOMPLETE.
- (F) **Payment of fee:** Candidates are required to pay the application fee through online mode only. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate. **Candidates are advised to take a print of the receipt of fee of Application Form for their records and future reference.**

13. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI):

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) registered under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 are also eligible to appear in PG courses and all terms and conditions for Indian Nationals will be applicable to the candidates. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 to be eligible to appear for this test.

14. SUBMISSION OF CASTE CERTIFICATE BY SC/ST/OBC CANDIDATES:

For all purposes Candidate applying under **OBC** (NCL) category, the candidate must possess a certificate issued by competent authority (as applicable to category/format provided by AIIMS Raipur) within one year of last date for Online Registration 02.06.2024 (i.e. issued between 01.06.2023 to 02.06.2024) and for EWS category, certificate should be issued on or after 01.04.2024 and be based on the income of year 2023-2024.

After declaration of result of the Entrance Examination, candidates belong to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes should submit, along with other requisite documents, an attested copy of a certificate from any one of the following **authorities stating that the candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Classes in the prescribed form.**

- A. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- B. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- C. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- D. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally resides.
- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorised in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of admission. This is as per the provisions made by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.07.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. 15. REASONS FOR REJECTION/CANCELLATION OF APPLICATION:

APPLICATIONS/CANDIDATURE OF APPLICANTS ARE LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED/REJECTED SUMMARILY OR AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF ALL OR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- i. Applications being incomplete.
- ii. Any variation in the Signatures.

All the SIGNATUREs in FULL (NOT IN SHORT) done on the Print out of the Application Form and also on other Documents must be the same.

- iii. Scanned copy of photograph and signature uploaded are not as per specification given and/or blur or distorted or not clear.
- iv. Non-payment of Examination Fees or non-receipt of fee through online mode, if not otherwise exempted.

- v. Fee not paid as per instructions.
- vi. 16. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

 - f) Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.

 - i) Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the Supervisor, Invigilator or representative of AIIMS, Raipur.
 - j) Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by AIIMS, Raipur for the conduct of examination.
